

The Holy Land 2021 – 1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022

Dear Friend,

I would like to invite you to join Linda and myself on a 10 day Holy Land trip which will include 4 nights in Jerusalem followed by 2 days in the Judean desert with a night in Beer Sheva, followed by 4 nights in Galilee. This is a fantastic opportunity to not only visit some of the main places we normally travel to but with the bonus of a desert excursion in the south, and a trip to the very north of the country in Galilee visiting Caesarea Philippi and Mount Hermon. One of the best parts of a trip like this is the fellowship we share as a group on tour together, experiencing and sharing what we discover as we travel.



**Please note that because of the current Covid-19 pandemic, you are not expected to pay any initial deposit until early 2022.** We are planning this trip in the hope that travel will still be possible in March (as it is currently), so we are simply inviting expressions of interest. Once the situation becomes clearer and deposits need to be paid, you will be asked to pay a deposit of £200 per person, and will be able to withdraw your interest if you wish. If the numbers are not enough or the situation changes, the trip will not go ahead, so you are fully protected. However, it will help planning if you can use the enclosed registration form or on-line registration to indicate your interest.
